

Worship and Music Ministry Team

Work Process and Responsibilities

2021-2022

The Worship committee helps carry out the vision and mission of the church through worship. This team works with the Pastor to plan regular and special worship services that nurture and enhance the life of the congregation.

The Music and Worship team has four subcommittee's as follows:

Special Music: The Music subcommittee plans and schedules the appropriate vocalists or musicians ensuring that the necessary people are scheduled each week. The pastor provides the sermon topic and the hymns to be used for the service. The music committee works with the pastor to coordinate which hymns will be led by the praise band and which hymns will be led by the organ or the piano. The choir director with the pastor uses the sermon topic to choose the music to fit the topic. This subcommittee assists in the recruiting, hiring process and oversight of the choir vocal section leaders.

Lay leaders: The lay leader subcommittee recruit members to assist the pastor in worship service as lay leaders. They will help with scripture and prayers as directed by the Pastor.

Ushers and Greeters: The Usher and Greeters Subcommittee recruit members to be ushers and greeters for each Sunday Worship service. Greeters welcome all who come to worship. Ushers hand out bulletins at the entrances to the sanctuary, assist those that need help to get to a pew, pass the offering baskets and take the offering to the communion table, put the attendance books in the pews and collect them after worship service. Remove any bulletins left in the pews. Because of covid-19 ushering and greeting has been changed until we feel it is safe to return to the way we normally do ushering.

Power point operators: The power point subcommittee recruit members to run the laptop that is connected to the overhead projectors which displays the Sunday worship service using the power point program.

The Worship and Music Team with the help of church members oversee the Liturgical colors and put up the correct paraments according to the Presbyterian yearly planning Calendar. The Worship and Music Team with the help of church members oversee the special holiday decorations, such as Christmas and Easter.
