Worship for Sunday, February 12:

“What’s the Point?”

Scripture: Deuteronomy 30:15-20; Matthew 5:21-37 – What is the purpose of God’s law? In our gospel reading, Jesus interprets the laws on murder, adultery, and making vows, and it gets a little uncomfortable. Our Hebrew scripture reading reveals a choice between life and death, prosperity and adversity. In both readings God calls for justice and respect in relationships. How might that look in our current context? How have these scriptures been interpreted in the past for good or ill?

Looking Toward Lent

The season of lent begins in two weeks on Ash Wednesday, February 22. While Presbyterians haven’t always participated in the Lenten season, many have found that it can be a time of growth in faith through prayer, increased attentiveness, and individual and communal healing. This year we will be journeying through Lent guided by the art creativity, and theological reflection of the team at [A Sanctified Art](#).

Our [Lenten Worship Series](#) is called, **SEEKING: Honest Questions for Deeper Faith**. “Each Sunday we will learn about folks in scripture who are seeking a new beginning, a different life, a deeper faith. What unfolds is an exchange filled with questions and exploration. Often, an unveiling occurs—assumptions are disrupted, a new perspective is revealed, mystery grows. Like the characters in our Lenten scriptures, we are also seeking many things: clarity, connection, wonder, justice, balance. Throughout this season, we hope you will continually ask yourself: what am I seeking? What is God seeking?”

Our [Wednesday Lenten Reflections](#) will explore our, **I’ve Been Meaning to Ask**, series more deeply. Last summer we spent eight Sundays with questions designed to foster courage, curiosity, and connection in our faith community. This Lent we seek to deepen our connections as we break bread together pondering, “Where are you from?”, “Where does it hurt?”, “What do you need?” and “Where do we go from here?”. We will gather in the dining room to share a simple meal, watch a video vignette, and reflect together at our tables. We will meet for an hour,—from 5:30pm to 6:30pm—on March 1, 8, 22, and 29.
