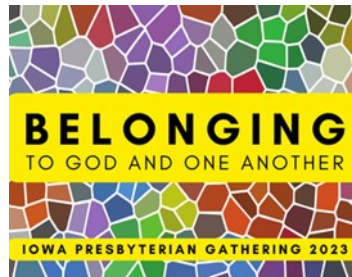
Pastor Julie Away from the Office
