### Information about Efi Latsoudi:

Efi Latsoudi of Greece is a psychologist, filmmaker, and human rights advocate. She serves refugees and asylum seekers fleeing to Europe from Africa, the Middle East, and Asia. She is one of the founders of Lesvos Solidarity, a grass-roots organization based on Lesvos Island in Greece. Efi was also the coordinator and founder of the first open, independent welcoming shelter (Pipka Camp) for refugees fleeing to Greece primarily from Africa and the Middle East. She has received international awards for her work.

Efi is also a filmmaker who has created short documentaries and films. Efi holds degrees from the University of Athens, School of Philosophy, the University of Picardi-Jules Vernes in Maitrise de Psychology Clinic and the University of Paris.
