

2025 Income Sources 2025 Expense Distribution

These two charts show where the income for the church comes from and how

the money is utilized. Staff salaries have been allocated to the expense categories based on the percentage time spent on worship, church programs and missions. Mission benefited from a \$5000 infusion from last year's budget surplus.

Corporate similarly benefited from a \$4520 infusion to the Properties fund from last year's budget surplus. Income from church members (including the 2024 carryover that went to Mission and Properties) continues to be our major

source of income but the income from other sources has increased from 9% to

13% since 2022.
