Scriptures: Isaiah 7:10-16, Matthew 1:18-25

Sermon: "At the Turning Point"

Throughout Advent, we've read the stories of God's invitation over and over again. God goes to Elizabeth and Zechariah and says, "You." God goes to Mary and says, "You." God goes to Joseph and says, "You." As the church prepares to remember Jesus' first advent in the past even as it anticipates his second in the future, this Sunday affords the opportunity to proclaim that God is actively inviting us to share in God's work in the present. God is coming to us now and saying, "You." You personally. You specifically. It is you whom God has been waiting for, you whom God is inviting into the turning points that, right now, only God can see.
